1. 00:00:00 Introduction and Recognition of Mayor and Council elected by Stewart Elementary student body

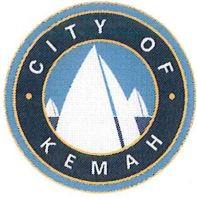
