HB 3693 Compliance Report - 2017



The City of Kemah complies with the requirements of HB 3693 (Government Code § 2264.001 (b)) by compiling and posting the total metered amount of electricity, water and natural gas used by the city and the aggregate costs for these services.

The City of Kemah purchases natural gas from CenterPoint Energy. In Calendar Year 2017, the City purchased a total of <u>709</u> thousand cubic feet (MCF) of natural gas.

The City purchases electricity from Gexa Energy.

In calendar year 2017, the City of Kemah purchased a total of <u>670,086</u> kilowatt hours.

The City purchases water from Galveston County Water Control and Improvement District #12. In calendar year 2017, the City of Kemah purchased a total of **2,451.21** gallons of water.

The total cost of natural gas, electricity and water purchased by the City in the calendar year 2017 was \$ 128,629.04.
