ORDINANCE NO. 1101

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING CERTAIN OFFICERS TO FILE A SWORN DISCLOSURE OF INTEREST(S) IN REAL PROPERTY IN THE CITY OR IN A CORPORATION OR BUSINESS ENTITY UNDER CONTRACT WITH THE CITY; PROVIDING CONSEQUENCES INCLUDING FORFEITURE OF OFFICE FOR MALFEASANCE FOR VIOLATION OF SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KEMAH, TEXAS THAT:

The members of Council, the City Administrator, and the members of the Kemah Community Development Corporation shall within 30 days of election or appointment, complete and file with the City Secretary a sworn disclosure statement, on a form generated by the City for that purpose, listing all interests in real property located within the city limits or the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City, whether owned outright or under a mortgage or lease, or held in trust by another party or held by said officer's spouse or dependent children. This disclosure shall include the location of said real property (street address or legal description), its size and current use. Furthermore, this disclosure shall include his or her ownership of stock or membership interest in a company or business entity under contract with the City or on an agenda for consideration for a contract with the City, when such ownership comprises more than one percent of the business entity's total stock or membership. This section shall become effective for the current members of council, the City Administrator, and the members of the Kemah Community Development Corporation within 30 days of final passage of this ordinance. Thereafter, all officers named herein shall file an amended statement within 30 days of the acquisition of any additional real property interest as defined above or stock or interest in a corporation or business entity as defined above. This requirement to disclose shall apply to such officers during the term of any elected office, appointed office or employment (in the case of the City Administrator) of that officer. Any willful violation of this section or this ordinance shall constitute malfeasance in office and shall be cause for removal for such malfeasance in office and any such elected or appointed official or employee guilty thereof shall forfeit the office or position and shall be subject to removal from office in a manner authorized by law.


